GREENWOOD LAKE, bumped at the start and outrun early, rallied inside on the turn, came wide for the drive, and finished determinedly to be clear under the wire. MANDARIN MARSH, hustled along early, rallied inside and dug in gamely in the stretch but could resist the winner. SAINT JOSEPH, bumped at the start, rallied inside on the turn and continued gamely to the finish. BLUSTERY, bumped at the start and put to the whip on the backstretch, raced wide throughout and finished with good interest. MCILHENY, ducked in at the start and was bumped then chased outside and weakened late. DE ROMA, outrun early, while racing very greenly, was going well late despite being steadied in the stretch. HALO KRIS was hustled from the gate, chased the pace, was steadied on the turn, came four wide for the drive but lacked a rally. MEGAWATT, bumped at the start, put in a four wide run on the turn and tired in the stretch. GLOBAL THREAT set the pace and gave way in the stretch. DARK GUEST, bumped at the start, chased the pace and tired.
