ZAVATA raced close up while four wide in hand, came in approaching the stretch, drew away when roused and was kept to the task to the wire. LONE STAR SKY was hustled along early, picked it up midway on the turn, was taken up in tight quarters approaching the stretch then rallied outside to be clearly best of the others. SPITE THE DEVIL was hustled along inside, put in a run along the rail nearing the stretch and drifted out while tiring in deep stretch. AWESOME OF COURSE broke running, quickly showed in front, set the pace and tired in the stretch. DESERT WARRIOR chased the pace from the outside and tired after a half mile.
