STORM ON THE LAKE outprinted rivals for the early advantage, set the pace slightly off the rail to the turn, maintained a clear lead to the top of the stretch, extended her margin in midstretch then held sway under steady urging. KINGS EMPRESS prompted the pace outside the winner into upper stretch but was no match for that one while holding gamely for the place. COMBANCHERA raced well back for a half after breaking a bit slowly, circled five wide into the stretch then rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. BEHRNIK devoid of early speed, trailed for a half, launched a rally in upper stretch then finished well while splitting rivals in the late stages. GONE MUSICAL raced within striking distance while four wide into upper stretch and weakened in the final eighth. COLOGNY settled just off the early pace, saved ground to the turn, made a run between horses to reach contention in upper stretch but couldn't sustain her bid. HUSSY showed only brief speed while saving ground. There was a ten minute delay before the start of the race due to a power failure.
