Footnotes

IRISH ROAD forced the pace from outside for a half, drew even with the leader entering the stretch, surged to the front in upper stretch and edged away under brisk urging. BANNED IN BOSTON rushed up to gain a clear early advantage, set the pace under pressure into upper stretch but couldn't stay with the winner through the final eighth. GUARDIAN raced up close along the rail for a half, angled three wide on the turn then lacked a strong closing response. LIMERO (ARG) was reserved for a half then failed to threaten with a mild late run along the inside. Y. V. FIVE was never a serious threat. TRADITIONAL raced in close contention while four wide for five furlongs and lacked a further response. REGAL BEAR never reached contention.
