Footnotes

READY'S CLYDE raced in hand for a half, steadied in traffic while saving ground on the turn, swung four wide between horses to get clear at the quarter pole, made a run to challenge in midstretch, opened a clear advantage in deep stretch and held off the runner-up under steady urging. FIND THE WIRE was reserved for a half while well off the rail, swung five wide while being bumped at the quarter pole and closed late in the middle of the track but could not get up. HOLIDAY TRIP raced in good position between horses for six furlongs, swung five wide at the quarter pole and rallied belatedly. HARD TO EXPLAIN (IRE) raced well back for a half, made a strong move in the two path on the turn, took the lead in upper stretch and weakened late. BURNS UP THE TRACK set the pace along the rail into upper stretch and gave way. PARTY JONES saved ground after breaking slowly and failed to mount a serious rally. LIL O'S EXPRESSION pressed the pace in the two path and faltered. PRIME OBSESSION raced in traffic early, saved ground for five furlongs and tired. FOUR STAR BO raced up close to the turn and gave way.
