Footnotes

PRIVATE RULES broke outward at the start, was urged along while off the pace, came under more vigorous urging while saving ground on the turn, moved off the rail nearing the quarter-pole, angled out while rallying in upper stretch, closed well on the inside of COOKS FOREST, gained the lead near the sixteenth-pole and proved best in a long drive. COOKS FOREST raced well back in the field while urged some, saved ground early on the turn, moved off the rail and split rivals passing the five-sixteenths pole, came three wide into the stretch, followed PRIVATE RULES out in upper stretch, closed well alongside that rival and finished willingly but was second best. EXLEY dueled on the outside of D' SAUVAGE, was asked for more when joined by SUPER ANGELO leaving the turn, briefly lost the lead to that rival then came right back, led into the final furlong and weakened while well clear for the show. SUPER ANGELO chased the dueling leaders from third, raced in the two path early on the turn, shifted three wide nearing the five-sixteenths pole, moved up to make a bid entering the stretch, gained a brief lead in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, was quickly re-headed then gave way. D' SAUVAGE hesitated at the start then came in under a right-handed whip, rushed up on the inside to duel for the lead, battled inside on the turn, was asked for all he had near the five-sixteenths pole, had no response and stopped. QUIET POWER was urged along a bit on the outside, came under more urging while three wide on the turn and failed to respond. ROBBIE'S TURN was away in good order, steadied between rivals in the early going, dropped back while very green on the inside, saved ground on the turn, weaved in and out in the stretch and faltered.
