Footnotes

HURRICANE DAY three wide around the opening bend, was guided one path closer to the inside midway down the backstretch, bided his time from there during the run around the far turn, angled out three wide at the quarter pole, while commencing to rally, closed in relentlessly during the ensuing furlong, by now having been placed to a vigorously hand ride, continued onward, then grabbed the lead a couple of jumps prior to the end to prove best. BAATESH accompanied the pacesetter from the outside while under a good hold until about midway on the far turn, was put to a strong drive nearing the five-sixteenths pole, made little if any progress until leaving the furlong grounds, gradually ranged up to the pacesetter, collared him in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, clung on to the narrow edge, failed to match the top's kick, yielding readily shortly before the wire. CHAIRMAN NOW made the lead under her own power soon after the start, showed the way on a loose-contested lead while towards the inside and under rating tactics, continued along on the same scenario until heading for the top of the lane, edged away a bit from her closer pursuer after being let out a notch, came under assault nearing the sixteenth pole and readily succumbed. CINNAMON BEACH reserved off the inside until the quarter pole, lacked the necessary stretch after being called upon. RITUAL unhurried in the two path, maneuvered over to the inside coming to the nine-sixteenths pole, was steadied when HURRICANE DAY came over ever so slightly, continued to take inside route, attempted an inside run to enter contention after turning for home, but wasn't up to the task. PROSPECTIVE UNION fought against the bit during the straightaway approach to the opening bend, acted more kindly by the midway point on that turn, tracked the leader from the rail, came up empty for the stretch drive. FU PEGS BABY entered the backstretch from the three path, failed to reach a contending position. QUINTUS SERTORIUS saved ground until the quarter pole to no avail.
