### Footnotes

STAY THIRSTY bobbed at the start but broke in front, showed good natural speed, dueled on the outside of FAIR WHIT without being asked for much, shook clear leaving the turn, was set down shortly thereafter and drew off under strong urging. WASHINGTON'S RULES was bumped hard on both sides at the start, moved to the inside, advanced past rivals while ridden along, swerved three wide leaving the backstretch, was hard ridden while three wide on the turn, closed the gap on the leaders coming to the quarter-pole but failed to match the winner while clear for the place in a solid effort. FAIR WHIT was hustled from the start, dueled on the inside of the winner, vied inside on the turn, dropped out nearing the quarter-pole and tired while just able to hold the show. ORSONIAN broke inward and bumped with a rival, moved out inside the five-eighths pole, dropped back while a bit green nearing the turn, brushed with ELTHEEB leaving the backstretch, was urged along while three wide on the turn, split rivals in the vicinity of the eighth-pole, moved out late and improved position. MAGNET COVE was bumped hard on both sides at the start then squeezed back, raced well behind the field while off the rail, moved out near the five-sixteenths pole, swung six wide into the stretch, bumped lightly with ELTHEEB near the sixteenth-pole and never reached contention. HEISMAN broke outward and bumped hard with MAGNET COVE at the start, showed some speed then was allowed to drop behind the dueling leaders, moved to the outside shortly thereafter, was hard ridden in the front half of the field, went three to four wide on the turn and faded. ELTHEEB was ridden along towards the rear, brushed with ORSONIAN leaving the backstretch, raced three to four wide on the turn, was close on heels while green nearing the quarter-pole, came five wide into the stretch, was close on heels while still green shortly thereafter, bumped lightly with MAGNET COVE while out of contention near the sixteenth-pole and was no factor. BROCK was ridden along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to respond then retreated. CALL THE BALL lacked early speed, was carried out a bit inside the five-eighths pole, dropped in to save ground on the turn and showed little.
