WELCOME DANCE was fractious in the gate, showed good speed, was well rated while setting the pace, responded well when asked nearing the quarter-pole, accelerated clear from BARGAIN BLITZ near the three-sixteenths pole, came under a left-handed whip and held under continued left hand urging then a hand ride late. BARGAIN BLITZ was restless in the gate, raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, was asked outside the quarter-pole, chased the winner in the stretch and was second best. WAIT TIL DAWN brushed with a rival after the start, was rated on the inside, moved up outside the half-mile pole, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, saved ground into the stretch, came under right hand urging and finished willingly to get the show. DISPOSABLEPLEASURE was forced out at the start, saved ground while under restraint, moved closer with a half-mile to run, continued inside on the far turn, was asked approaching the quarter-pole, swung out at the top of the stretch, angled further out for clearance near the three-sixteenths pole and finished willingly. CAT GIRL was reserved while off the inside, waited between rivals on the far turn, was asked nearing the quarter-pole, shifted four wide at the top of the stretch, moved further out near the three-sixteenths pole and gained some ground but lacked the needed kick. ISRA veered out at the start, saved ground on the first turn, was well placed while off the inside on the backstretch, raced between rivals on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came under a drive in upper stretch and weakened. REMARKABLE MOON steadied after the start, spotted the field a few lengths, was unhurried at the back, saved ground on the turns and failed to rally. COASTING broke a bit slow then was slow into stride, lingered near the back of the field, went three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. MISS RET broke out at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and came up empty. ISLAND PRAYER brushed with a rival after the start, settled off the rail on the first turn, moved out midway down the backstretch, came under urging near the seven-sixteenths pole, went four wide on the far turn and had nothing left. (Rail at 18 Feet)
