WILDCAT'S SMILE ducked inward at the start, was grabbed hold, put to some hand urging and took up position near the front along the inside, remained under some light encouragement tracking the front runners, slipped to the outside just past the five-sixteenths pole, squeezed her way between rivals coming to the quarter pole, and once successfully through showed a quick burst of speed to grab the lead and kick clear of the competition, was asked for more in upper stretch and lengthened away to a commanding advantage, added to it, crossing the finish line under a vigorous hand ride. BERNING CARBS widest on the turn, powered up under her own courage to reach contention by the end of the turn, was unable to keep pace with the top one after turning for home, but finished with good energy nonetheless to be second best. PROUD AND CHARMING bumped lightly with SWEET GINGER after bobbling at the start, was slow to settle into stride, picked up speed and interest from midpoint on the turn, was already under some encouragement spinning four wide into upper stretch, rallied willingly to finish a non-threatening third. LENDERS WAY three wide, disputed the pace, the widest of a threesome until the three-eighths pole, remained a forward factor until upper stretch before backing away. STARSHIP PRINCESS vied for command between foes until midway on the turn, steadily tired thereafter. LADY SAMURI off the inside, tired. PROJECT RUNAWAY away alertly, argued for the lead from the inside with two others until midpoint on the turn, appeared to weakening when put in tight quarters by the winner coming to the quarter pole, was forced to steady and gave way. SWEET GINGER bumped lightly at the start, faded off a ground-saving journey.
