STAKES Adirondack S. Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES TWO YEARS OLD. No nomination fee. \$1,500 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$2,000 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any point prior to entry. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$1,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers if there are six (6) or more starters. All starters will be guaranteed no less than \$1,000. If only five (5) or less start the purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 6% to fourth and 4% to fifth. A bonus of \$200,000 jointly sponsored by Fasig-Tipton and NYRA will go to the owner of the first two-year-old purchased at the 2010 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Selected Yearlings sale to win a graded stake at Saratoga (The Schuylerville, The Sanford, The Adirondack, The Three Chimneys Saratoga Special, The With Anticipation, The Spinaway or The Three Chimneys Hopeful.) 122 lbs.

Non-winners of \$40,000 allowed 2 lbs.; a race other than maiden or claiming, 4 lbs. A Trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, July 30, 2011 with 23 Nominations.

MY MISS AURELIA out broke the field but was soon joined by BELLACOURT along the inside, sparred with that opponent, with the rider sitting aboard chilly, felt the presence of the runner up approaching the five-sixteenths pole, was given some rein and moved in tandem with that rival past BELLACOURT, the more energetically handled of the pair, turned for home and was let out, as was MILLIONREASONSWHY as the stretch duel began in earnest, stubbornly clung to a slim advantage as the embattled twosome made their way towards the furlong marker, dug in with good determination from that station to the wire, refusing to yield command. MILLIONREASONSWHY the last to pop out of the starting gate, sat perched three wide off the pace dispute, advanced when ready from midpoint on the turn, sped past BELLACOURT in unison with the top one, still unasked for any run, entered the stretch two wide and got called upon, raced as a team with the winner during the next furlong, tried valiantly but was unable to go, while obviously second best. BELLACOURT urged to the front, dueled with the top one until the five-sixteenths pole, fell back, overwhelmed at this point, went on to best the rest for show honors. NEW WAVE took the inside route, was put to a prolonged drive, failed to reach a contending position. ANNA SOPHIA raced along the outside and was outrun.
