Footnotes

API MOHKAT angled in after sprinted clear in the early stages, set the pace on the rail into upper stretch and drew off with authority while being kept to a drive. CHARGING HERO steadied after being pinched back at the start, moved out in the early stages, angled to the inside on the far turn, raced well back for a half, saved ground while launching his bid in upper stretch and closed late to gain the place. AT ATTENTION raced just off the early pace, ranged up four wide to reach contention nearing the quarter pole and rallied mildly to gain a share. ESTIMATOR broke a bit slowly, steadied along the inside while being bothered near the five-eighths pole, saved ground while in tight on the far turn, angled out a bit entering the stretch, made a mild move in midstretch and flattened out. BOBCAT BRODY never reached contention while five wide. TOUGH JAKE broke inward causing crowding at the start, raced erratically in the early stages bothering ESTIMATOR in the process, pressed the pace in the two path to the top of the stretch then gave way.
