COOKRAM ROCK was reserved along the inside during the initial half, came off the inside while being mildly encouraged at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide into the stretch, rallied in earnest once given his cue, gobbled up real estate readily with long strides, continued onward leaving the furlong grounds, then collared the leader a couple of jumps prior to the finish line to prove best. MOTION PLAY well placed along the outside, commenced his bid for the lead approaching the head of the stretch, poked a head in front at the eighth pole, attempted to stave off the top one when that foe arrived on the scene, wasn't up to the task, surrendering shortly before reaching the end. GOLLY DAY unhurried during the opening stages, raced three wide around the far turn, entered the lane a bit wider, displayed a good kick en route for the show. SOUTHERN SAINT sped off to an open lead, showed the way while well off the inside down the backstretch, resisting several attempts to be guided closer to the inside, was eventually worked over to the two path upon reaching the far turn, continued along from there unchallenged until the quarter pole, was put to the test soon afterwards, offered good resistance until midstretch, yielded and weakened steadily thereafter. WINNING TOKEN taken hold of early during the straightaway approach to the opening bend, continued to fight against the bit at various points along the backstretch, ranged up when given a bit more rein on the second bend, made a mild bid for the lead, and backed off. DBL NVISABL GEORGE saved ground, made a nice run along the inside to loom a serious threat with an eighth to go, flattened out from that point under light encouragement. RAVEN'S CHOICE was steadied during the early going, rode the rail and failed to fire after being called upon. ROYAL LORD was through after going a half.
