### Footnotes

IN STEP was hustled to the lead then set the pace under her own power, accelerated further clear inside the five-eighths pole, controlled the tempo while off the rail on the turn, came under urging near the five-sixteenths pole, was given one crack of a left-handed whip outside the furlong marker, immediately switched to a right-handed whip and held sway under continued right hand urging. INDIAN TALE was bumped in the hindquarters after the start then was taken in hand and dropped back, raced well off the pace while under some urging, moved closer with a half-mile to run, saved ground on the turn, gained under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, loomed a threat entering the final furlong and finished willingly but couldn't get by the winner. SHARED HEART was ridden along on the outside, raced five wide on the turn, drifted in some in upper stretch, was put to a left-handed whip, switched to a right-handed whip inside the furlong marker and finished willingly to get the show. HEAVENLY LANDING bumped with LADY GRACENOTE after the start then tried to savage that rival, dropped back then was ridden along towards the rear, went three wide on the turn and lacked the needed response while gaining some ground. RAFFIE'S ROSE hit the outside of the gate at the start, was ridden along on the outside, raced four on the turn, dropped to three wide outside the quarter-pole and also lacked the needed response. LADY GRACENOTE bumped with rivals after the start, savaged back at HEAVENLY LANDING after that rival did the same, dropped back then was ridden along at the rear, went two then three wide on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and gained some ground but failed to menace. EARTHLIY RESERVES was urged along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and capitulated. VICTORIA LYNN chased the solo leader, raced three wide on the turn and tired.
