MR ALGEBRA raced three wide around both turns, forwardly placed when excluding the loose leader, remained unhurried for nearly three-quarters, was given a few shakes of the reins leaving the five-sixteenths pole and picked up interest, was the widest of the two closest challengers zeroing in on RELENTLESS ROAD as the field turned for home, grabbed the lead away a sixteenth down the lane and was sent over towards the rail, emerged from the furlong grounds holding a comfortable advantage and went on to extend it, put to a strong hand drive. POPPLESTONE saved ground early, swung outward until four wide by the head of the stretch, displayed a good kick down the center of the course to garner the place although never posing a threat to the winner. LION PRINCE swung off the rail entering the backstretch, sat reserved in the middle of the pack until late on the far turn, was under some urging coming three wide into the stretch, got outfinished. RELENTLESS ROAD spurted away from the competition, without being asked for any speed, set the brisk opening splits, proving ratable and isolated on the front, arrived at the quarter pole facing intensified pressure and was let out in response, yielded to the top one in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole and steadily weakened. DENDRITE stalked the leader from afar, moved up as a prelude to challenging in earnest during the later stages of the run around the far turn, kept up the bid for about a sixteenth before flattening out. MY PAL OF PALS rubbed shoulders with TOUGH ALL DAY at the break, was in tight and steadied off heels nearing the end of the homestretch, was taken inward, cut the corner into

the stretch, failed to have an impact. JIM JAMM strung out three wide on the first turn, was outrun. TOUGH ALL DAY made slight contact with MY PAL OF PALS at the start, tucked along the rail just before reaching the first turn, tracked from afar, began to close in from the five-sixteenths pole, got eased into the two path and put to some encouragement spinning into the stretch, was taken in hand, precariously off heels as DENDRITE inadvertently drifted inward in upper stretch, flattened out soon afterwards. DUAL MANDATE saved ground until the five-sixteenths pole, came up empty when called upon for the stretch run, was reported to have bled and was vanned off after the finish.
