Footnotes

BOOTS AHEAD firmly held tracking the leader from the three path, was under patient handling until nearing the quarter pole, got set down at that station, edged clear through the lane kept busy to the end. FRESHMAN DORM hit the near side stall at the start and was off a beat slow as a result, settled towards the rear two to three wide, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths spun four wide for home, kicked on with late energy through the final sixteenth getting up in the last jumps to procure the place. WAR HOOT just off the pace along the inside, came under urging at the quarter pole, had to briefly stall and wait for a clear lane to the three sixteenths, came under urging when clear moved decisively into the place spot with good kick before being outfinished in the last jumps and forced to settle for the show. BELL BY THE RIDGE steadied early on approaching the seven-eighths pole as ANNAWON tucked in one path closer under firm hold, raced three to four deep progressing into close range steadily throughout, got called upon at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide for home, offered up a mild kick for the last major share. ANNAWON just off the pace three wide throughout, got spirited up at the quarter pole, was out kicked through the lane before weakening in the late stages. PLEASANT RUN jostled between rivals just after the start getting squeezed out between, settled at the rear two to three wide, spun four wide in upper stretch, passed tired rivals in the lane. FASTEST MAGICIAN saved ground from midpack, came under coaxing just past the three-eighths, was set down in earnest at the five-sixteenths and offered no response. GLOWING PRAISE (GB) well rated

on the front just off the inside, got displaced at the quarter pole, came under encouragement in response and tired. CINNAMON BEACH three wide in midpack, came under urging at the five-sixteenths and offered no kick.
