CITY ZIP broke running, pressed the pace while in hand, drew clear when roused and remained safely clear under a drive. SCORPION was hustled outside, rallied four wide on the turn and finished gamely outside. STANDARD SPEED raced inside and finished well. JACKSRBETTER was rated on the rail and was buried in traffic along the inside in the stretch. AMERICAN CENTURY chased the pace while three wide and tired in the final furlong. BROCCO BOB raced five wide and tired in the stretch. ZONE JUDGE stumbled badly at the start, was bumped after the start and was steadied on the rail on the turn. STRAIT CAT ducked out at the start, was bumped after the start, set the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch.
