ALL HAIL STORMY rushed up to gain a clear early advantage, extended his lead on the turn, remained well clear into midstretch then held off THUNDER TOUCH in the late stages. THUNDER TOUCH raced just off the race between horses, steadied in traffic on the far turn, swung five wide at the top of the stretch then closed late in the middle of the track but couldn't overtake the winner. BULL MARKET chased along the rail into upper stretch and steadily tired thereafter. CAT BUSTER was unhurried early, lodged a bid three wide to reach contention on the turn then faded in the stretch. RACE FOR GLORY failed to mount a serious rally while saving ground. DANDOON raced up close while three wide for a half and gave way.
