Footnotes

TRE' BON PRO dueled early from outside, opened a clear advantage in upper stretch and edged clear under intermittent right hand urging. SIMPLY PREFERRED checked slightly between horses and dropped back a bit in the early stages, worked her way forward three wide on the turn, angled out at the three-sixteenths pole and finished willingly to best the others. BLACK VELVET BAND raced well back for a half and failed to threaten with a mild late rally. FULL OF CLASS dueled inside the winner into upper stretch and weakened from her early efforts. QUICK HUMOR stalked the pace three wide to the top of the stretch and steadily tired thereafter. SUPREME JET checked along the inside at the half mile pole and failed to threaten thereafter. E. L. A.'S SWEETIE never reached contention after breaking slowly. DEVILISH MAX raced just behind the leaders while saving ground into upper stretch and steadily tired thereafter. JUDGE'S PRIDE steadied between horses in the early stages and swerved to the far outside, raced four wide to the turn and gave way.
