**Footnotes**

BOOGIE BOGGS was outrun for a half while saving ground, saved ground advancing into the stretch, angled out while gaining nearing the sixteenth pole, split rivals in deep stretch and just got up in the closing strides. MY GOLDEN OPINION hit the side of the gate and bobbled at the start, raced just off the pace along the inside into upper stretch, made a run to threaten in midstretch, angled around the leader while making a strong bid in deep stretch but couldn't hold the winner safe. CLIFTON PARK angled to the inside after sprinting clear in the early stages, set the pace into deep stretch and weakened late. ICE MAN COMETH was outrun to the turn after breaking slowly, circled four wide into the stretch then rallied belatedly from outside. COWTOWN CAT moved out along the backstretch, stalked the leaders while three wide into upper stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. MINT SLEWLEP trailed to the top of the stretch, swerved six wide in upper stretch and rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. GREAT DISCOVERY raced in midpack for a half, angled four wide on the turn and lacked a strong closing bid. FIRST DEGREE pressed the pace from outside for a half and gave way.
