Footnotes

LADY RIZZI bumped at the start, drifted out bumping with TWO REGAL along the backstretch, dueled inside for a half, shook loose in upper stretch and was never threatened while being kept to the task. WICKED QUEEN was reserved for a half, rallied four wide leaving the turn, drifted out in upper stretch and finished willingly to narrowly gain the place. THAT'S GOOD raced in midpack along the inside, saved ground into the stretch and finished strongly between horses in the late stages to narrowly miss the place. JETASTIK hurried early, checked in traffic between horses nearing the quarter pole, angled three wide entering the stretch, closed steadily between horses leaving the furlong marker and raced in traffic while gaining in the late stages. FIONA FREUD was bumped along the backstretch, contested the pace three wide to the turn and tired in the stretch. FREUDIAN SMILE lodged a mild bid inside on the turn, angled three wide in upper stretch and flattened out late. JAIMIES GEM bobbled and was pinched back at the start, never reached contention while four wide. MESO NOVA checked after being bumped at the start and was never close thereafter. TWO REGAL bounced around between horses on the backstretch, swung six wide at the quarter pole and gave way.
