### Footnotes

MARIA'S LUCK dropped back while urged along, was ridden along while off the rail on the turn, commenced a rally in upper stretch, closed well through a long drive and got up late under good handling. THATAGIRL was sent hard from the start, sprinted to a clear lead while under urging, continued in control while two to three wide on the turn, remained well clear into the final furlong, shortened stride while exhausted late and was caught. NOLITA chased the pace on the inside of TEA PARTY GAL, raced three wide on the turn and went evenly while able to secure the show. TEA PARTY GAL chased the pace on the outside then four wide on the turn and lacked the needed response. CEE'S FAST broke outward at the start, was hard ridden on the inside, saved ground on the turn and failed to rally. HURRICANE BARB broke a bit slow, was ridden along on the outside, raced three to four wide on the turn and failed to respond.
