SHOW SOME MAGIC came out alertly, grabbed a slim advantage and was tucked along the rail, argued to maintain the lead while being pressured by another pair during the run around the bend, turned for home still in possession of a slight edge and got called upon, reached the eighth pole with the runner up abreast, brushed with that opponent in the late stages, dug in with good determination to preserve the decision. GOMBEY DANCER lunged inward at the start, was pulled off the nearest opponent at that time before contact could be made, chased the disputed pace from off the inside, doing so from the four path by the five-sixteenths pole, was given his cue and advanced towards the winner, closing ground while lugging inward, reached the eighth pole latched on, brushed with the top one in deep stretch, with both parties bearing some responsibility for the contact, continued on with good courage, but couldn't go by. MIDNITE POPPA closed the gap during the softer second split on the turn, was fanned outward heading for the stretch, eventually settled into the five path by the three-sixteenths pole, rallied willingly to secure the show. TIZ FOR TAT in the three path, was the widest of three vying for command, backed away steadily after turning for home. WILL TAKE CHARGE took a hesitant first step departing the gate, saved ground and improved position with a mild stretch response. NATIONAL PRAYER tracked the front runners while sitting the pocket, was eased into the two path prior to quarter pole, sat on hold off a wall of four for about a sixteenth starting from that station, altered course outward for clearance, flattened out. TAKAJAO got off slowly, raced along the outside as a team with WILL TAKE CHARGE, as the pair brought up the rear, never reached a contending position. LINCOLN LAW was strongly hand urged to take up a forward position, disputed the pace from between rivals around the turn, gave way after entering the stretch.
