Footnotes

SMART FARDA bumped lightly with MACHO LIBRE nearing the first turn, dropped to the inside midway through that bend, moved up with six furlongs to run, dropped back while under urging inside the five-eighths pole, moved out in the vicinity the half-mile pole, was ridden along while three wide on the far turn, came under a right-handed whip near the five-sixteenths pole, rallied to the lead under left hand urging in upper stretch, switched back to a right-handed whip near the furlong marker and drew clear under steady handling. TWO OF A KIND went four wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, moved up with six furlongs to run, prompted the pace on the outside, gained the lead outside the three-eighths pole, kicked clear approaching the five-sixteenths pole, came under a left-handed whip at the top of the stretch, lost the lead to the winner, switched to a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker and proved no match while well clear for the place. LIGHT OF TRUTH dropped to the inside on the first turn, settled towards the inside, was urged along while near the inside on the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and narrowly earned the show. CAT MAN FU charged the front of the gate, smashed through the front a fraction before the rest of the stalls opened, was taken up and had the rider lose his left iron briefly, regained the iron after a few strides, raced towards the rear, came under urging outside the half-mile pole, saved ground on the far turn, came off the rail outside the quarter-pole while under the whip and just missed the show. TEAHUPOO went two to three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, dropped to fourth position as rivals advanced outside the five-eighths pole, was urged along while three then two wide on the far turn, moved closer to the inside nearing the quarter-pole, came under the whip in upper stretch, moved out near the sixteenth-pole and failed to rally. FOUR REDS was hustled from the start, set the pace through solid fractions, lost the lead outside the three-eighths pole, lugged out after dropping back near the five-sixteenths pole, drifted three wide at that point, floated four wide into the stretch and tired. KNOW THIS raced three wide on the first turn, dropped well behind while under some urging and was outrun. MACHO LIBRE bumped lightly with SMART FARDA while rank nearing the first turn, dropped back while very rank on that turn, settled more kindly on the backstretch, was roused with a half-mile to run, lugged out a bit leaving the backstretch, went two then three wide early on the far turn, moved to four wide outside the quarter-pole, came five wide into the stretch and failed to respond.
