STONELESS brushed with NO NUKES at the start then shied in and bumped with ECONOMY OF WORDS, moved up to take the lead, set the pace while off the inside, was given two taps of a down-turned whip near the five-sixteenths pole, extended the advantage under strong hand urging in upper stretch, was given two cracks of a right-handed whip in the vicinity of the furlong marker and drew off under strong handling. NO NUKES broke in and brushed with a rival then was sent hard, chased on the outside, was given two cracks of a right-handed whip in the process, went three wide on the turn while under intermittent right hand urging, switched to a left-handed whip in upper stretch and secured the place while no match for the winner. JEREK DETER broke a bit slow then was slow into stride, was urged along at the rear of the field, raced off the rail on the turn, came under a left-handed whip outside the quarter-pole, advanced into upper stretch and got up for the show. ACADIAN CONNECTION chased the pace, raced four wide on the turn, came under the whip near the five-sixteenths pole and tired. HEADING UPSTATE took a bit of an awkward stride just after the start, was ridden along on the outside, raced five wide on the turn, came under the whip near the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response. THINGAMAJIGGER stumbled at the start then was bumped soundly, chased the pace on the inside, saved ground on the turn and gave way. ECONOMY OF WORDS bumped with STONELESS at the start then came in and bumped hard with THINGAMAJIGGER, was hard ridden while off the pace, raced inside while under the whip on the turn and failed to respond.
