DAN AND SHEILA broke a bit awkwardly then was hustled, moved up leaving the chute then steadied on the inside of HOW DO I WIN, moved out then brushed with ACADIAN BLUES putting that rival in tight, tracked on the outside, went three wide on the turn, gained the lead at the quarter-pole, was put to a right-handed whip in upper stretch, inched clear into the final furlong, was switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and just held under strong urging. PHOTON settled on the outside, went three to four wide on the turn, was given his cue near the five-sixteenths pole, came under a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker, rallied on the outside, switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and closed strongly but missed. WILLY PAY came out in the early going, settled just off the pace while on the outside, went three then four wide on the turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, chased under right hand urging in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick while clear for the show. BIG CREEK bumped lightly with a rival at the start, dropped back between horses, settled at the rear, was roused while off the rail on the turn, shifted four wide outside the quarter-pole, came under the whip in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. VEE'S ACCOLADE bumped lightly with a rival at the start, was taken in hand then rated off the pace, moved up between rivals approaching the half-mile pole, drafted behind the leaders while off the rail on the turn, was asked to advanced between foes near the five-sixteenths pole, hesitated while lacking room, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, came under the whip and weakened. HOW DO I WIN broke out at the start, went to the front, was well rated while setting a tepid pace, came under some urging near the five-sixteenths pole, lost the lead at the top of the stretch, came under the whip, lost touch with the winner near the furlong marker and gave way. ACADIAN BLUES brushed with DAN AND SHEILA near the three-quarter pole then was taken up while in tight, settled off the pace, saved ground on the turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, came under a drive in upper stretch and failed to respond.
