LAGUNA GIRL broke alertly in tandem with FEVERED KISS, pressed the pace on the outside, chose the three path on the turn, took the lead near the five-sixteenths, inched clear coming to the quarter-pole, dropped in a bit while asked at the top of the stretch, came under a left-handed whip near the furlong marker and held well under continued left-hand urging. MAHNA bumped soundly with CONZIG at the start then jostled with that opponent, was ridden along while off the pace, went three then four wide on the turn, advanced into striking range in upper stretch, drifted in under a left-handed whip outside the eighth-pole, pursued the winner while racing a bit erratically in the final furlong and flattened out then was taken in hand late while clearly second best. DELANY ROAD was well placed in third position, raced off the rail early on the turn, was asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, shifted three wide late on the bend, came under the whip turning into the stretch, chased the winner briefly then weakened while able to get the show. CONZIG bumped soundly with MAHNA at the start then jostled with that rival and was taken up in tight quarters, raced at the rear of the field, saved ground early on the turn, swerved four wide near the three-eighths pole, moved to five wide near the quarter-pole, floated seven wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. FEVERED KISS was away alertly in unison with the winner, set the pace under pressure, vied inside on the turn, lost the lead near the five-sixteenths, dropped out at the quarter-pole and gave way. ROYALTY was urged along on the outside, angled in at the half-mile pole, was hard ridden while a bit off the rail on the turn and failed to respond.
