AWESOME VISION raced three wide on both turns, crept into contention during the run around the second one, turned for home and responded positively when called upon, was the outermost of three arriving nearly together at the eighth pole, shook free in deep stretch then dug in with good determination to preserve the decision. BIGGER IS BETTOR sat reserved within striking distance at or near the two path until late on the second bend, was put to urging and swung three wide into the stretch, jostled with ZETTERHOLM for position, exchanging several light bumps with that foe while at the same time being denied access further outward, took off in earnest after the front runners with clear sailing ahead, pilot atop with a firm grip on the right, was battling between rivals for much of the final furlong, gamely procured the place. MOST HAPPY FELLA hard to load into the starting gate even with blindfold on, proceeded to come away in good order, established command and was sent over to the inside, cut the pace, being rated, and with a well-rated GROOMEDFORVICTORY parked out in the two path, had a change in those conditions as the pair headed for the three-eighths pole, left that station being put to the test by the previously-named opponent, entered the stretch and got called upon, was in the middle of two others reaching the furlong marker with only heads separating each and with the eventual runner up now bearing down hard, fought with vigor before backing away with less than a sixteenth remaining. ANAPHYLAXIS on the rail on each turn, was mostly along the outside down the backstretch, flip-flopping paths with ZETTERHOLM, fought with some force on the bit during a good portion of the early going, cut the corner into the lane, was given his cue and unleashed a solid burst of speed to loom a bold threat with an eighth to go, flattened out. ZETTERHOLM briefly sent on to the inside route after leaving the first turn, was taken back outward before reaching the next one, raced three wide, loosely drafting behind the winner, took the four path for entrance into the lane, bumped lightly several times with the second place finisher refusing to yield his path, lacked the needed response. SO SCOTT saved ground to no avail. GROOMEDFORVICTORY rated prompting the pacesetter from the two path, made an abbreviated bid midpoint on the far turn, gave way.
