Footnotes

VOODOO pressed the pace from outside along the backstretch, drew along side HERE'S ZEALOUS to challenge at the quarter pole, dueled outside that one into deep stretch and prevailed after a long drive. HERE'S ZEALOUS angled in along the backstretch, opened a clear advantage on the far turn, moved to the rail while battling heads apart approaching the stretch, fought gamely into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. HOOK AND LADDER raced up close along the rail to the top of the stretch and held well for a share. MAYBRY'S BOY trailed along the backstretch, circled five wide on the turn then lacked a strong closing bid. ELITE MERCEDES failed to mount a serious rally. VODKA was never a factor while four wide. SAY FLORIDA SANDY never reached contention.
