CHACE CITY pressed the pace in hand between horses along the backstretch, moved to the front leaving the five-sixteenths pole, shook loose entering the stretch, opened a clear advantage in midstretch then held off KING OF THE ROXY under strong encouragement. KING OF THE ROXY stalked the leaders while three wide for a half, took up chase after the winner in upper stretch then closed gradually from outside but could not get up. SHERMANESQUE settled in good position along the inside, was rated just off the pace while saving ground to the turn, altered course to the outside for room in upper stretch and lacked a strong closing response. ACTIN GOOD dueled inside the winner to the top of the stretch and drifted out while tiring in the final eighth. TEUFLESBERG stumbled badly at the start, moved up between horses along the backstretch, raced within striking distance while continuing between horses through the turn and gave way in upper stretch. FAST N READY steadied while under a snug hold at the half mile pole, dropped back on the turn and was never close thereafter.
