STORMY WEST checked early between horses, moved four wide entering the backstretch, raced well back to the turn, lodged a bid from outside entering the stretch then finished strongly to get up in the final seventy yards. MILK TOWN prompted the pace in the two path, made a run to challenge on the turn, opened a clear advantage in upper stretch, led into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. BEES raced in traffic between horses, angled four wide at the quarter pole and rallied belatedly. WAQUOIT'S LOVE settled in good position along the inside, waited patiently on the turn, made a run to reach contention in upper stretch and finished evenly. DOWN checked and was pinched back early, was outrun to the turn then raced in traffic along the inside while lacking clear sailing through a good portion of the stretch run. MORE THAN A FEELIN steadied between horses on the first turn lodged a mild bid to threaten in upper stretch and flattened out. MOONLIGHT FLITE failed to mount a serious rally while four wide throughout. MYTHICAL ECHO never reached contention. SKIRMISH was used up setting the early pace.
