MALIBU ARTISTE was urged almost from the get-go, underwent a four wide pursuit, commenced a prolonged hard drive during the run around the bend, gained readily on the embattled front runners after entering the stretch, wrested away command a short distance past the eighth pole and kicked clear. MARGARET SMILE gave chase from the two path, angled out gradually to be five wide coming to the three-sixteenths pole to gain optimal racing clearance, finished with good belatedly energy to procure place honors. DOES IT EVERY TIME three wide, vied between rivals from the five-sixteenths pole until midstretch before backing away. CATTY MADELINE three wide at the three-eighths pole, lacked the necessary stretch response. IBERIAN GATE argued for the lead from off the inside, faced heavy pressure heading for the top of the stretch, held her ground until the eighth pole, then succumbed. IN HER HEY DAY hustled away from the starting gate to assume a forward position, disputed the pace from the inside and gave way.
