LADY COHIBA tracked the front under reserve along the inside, ranged up under her own power to intensify the pressure on the leader at the five-eighths pole, remained under a patient hold and gradually eased back into the far turn, came under a drive nearing the five-sixteenths, angled out one path for a clear lane at the three-sixteenths, had the eventual runner up drift out under heavy near sided stick work and shadowed that action a furlong out, got on track at the sixteenth pole with dead aim, surged by in the last strides to prevail while lightly bumped on the line by her drifting foe. MOMENT IN DIXIE broke in at the start bumping CIAO BELLA before being corrected, sat well held just off the pace from the three path, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, drifted out under heavy near sided stick work at the eighth pole being corrected before any contact could be made with the aforementioned rival, took over command a sixteenth out, led to near finish, drifted out at the wire bumping LADY COHIBA while caught on the line and forced to settle for the place honors. HARBOR MIST well rated on the pace in the two path, got set down approaching the quarter pole, fought on determined to the sixteenth pole clinging to a narrow lead, was displaced at that station and weakened in the late stages while safe for show. CIAO BELLA bumped at the start when MOMENT IN DIXIE broke inwards, raced three to four wide throughout under reserve until the three-eighths pole, was let out at that station and made no impact. LEMON SPLENDOR threw her head at the start, raced two to three wide at the rear, came under a prolonged drive from the half mile pole while trailing throughout.
