HESSONITE came away in good order, swung three wide into the backstretch, loosely drafted behind HOT SPLASH until nearing the end of the second turn, was cued up with a tap near the right shoulder and spun into the lane, gained ground readily from upper to midstretch, took over the lead a couple of jumps past the eighth pole, was a body length to the good a sixteenth later, edged away under good handling. MYSTIC CITY assumed a forward position soon after the start, stalked the pacesetter, without any real pressure on that rival until nearing the end of the backstretch, crept up and drew alongside during the run around the far turn, got called upon for the stretch drive, failed to keep pace with the winner departing the furlong grounds, but continued onward willingly to procure the place. ELUSIVE RUMOUR quickly took control and spurred away from the competition, was lightly hand coaxed setting the early splits while saving ground, had the runner up increase the pressure upon entering the far turn, was set down entering the stretch, reached the furlong marker desperately clinging to the barest of leads, had it taken away in short order, eventually weakening into the show slot. GITCHEE GOOMIE sat unhurried from the two path for most of the opening stages, briefly waited for suitable options approaching the quarter pole, entered the lane wedged between rivals momentarily, altered course outward once past the furlong grounds, lacked the appropriate kick. DREAMING OF CARA was no menace. CONSIDERATE proceeded down the homestretch under a strong hold on the reins by the rider, rated well thereafter while tracking the pacesetter from the pocket, faltered after turning for home. HOT SPLASH underwent a three wide journey, was set down by the five-sixteenths pole, folded.
