MIDNIGHT TABOO forwardly placed while three wide on each turn, ranged up towards the front runners approaching the five-sixteenths pole, spun into the lane, as the widest of a threesome and was asked for a response, gave it, cutting into the leader's margin during the ensuing furlong, had a duel commence at that point and forged on ahead with continued success, grabbed away the lead for good in the late stages and inched away, confidently ridden for the last few jumps. GOLDEN LAD brushed with MAGIC HARBOUR at the start, suffered no significant consequences and grabbed the advantage, was guided over to the rail, got rated, being prompted by an equally-rated SLIVER AND ONIONS parked to the outside, had the winner make his presence felt coming to the five-sixteenths pole, went on a little farther then got set down, held his ground well to arrive at the eighth pole still the clear leader, sparred intensely with the winner thereafter before being displaced in the final seventy yards. KID SIDNEY tracked the front runners while sitting the pocket trip, was under a drive cutting the corner, made no headway on the first two finishers, held on well enough to save the show award. THE BEST GLACIER swung three wide entering the backstretch, remained as wide departing it, steadily advanced towards the pacesetter, was already encouragement taking the four path for entrance into the stretch, gained ground gradually. SLIVER AND ONIONS contently prompted the pacesetter from the two path, continued in the task, but only from between opponents during the later stages of the run around the second bend, was called upon turning for home, fought with the first two finishers for about another sixteenth before giving way. INDY'S ILLUSION raced along the outside, had felt the whip by the five-sixteenths marker, had no response. THIRD KNIGHT broke out sharply, was grabbed hold and pulled away in time to prevent anything more than leaning upon SLIVER AND ONIONS, took the inside route, was asked for run prior to the quarter pole, faltered. MAGIC HARBOR made light contact with the runner up at the break, rode the rail in the

early going, got tipped outward until three wide and under encouragement leaving the three-eighths pole, trailed.
