LAWYER JIM hit the near side stall at the start popping the rider to the near side nearly dismounting him save for a impulsive reflex to brace against ABRA and return upright, settled saving ground towards the rear, came under light coaxing nearing the quarter pole, angled out three wide straightening for home bumping ATTENBOROUGH out to the four path lightly in the process, burst through a seam nearing the eighth pole and surged through to take over and inch away, then was kept busy to the wire to prevail. TATER DOWNS saved ground settled at the rear scraping the hedge, came under light coaxing inside at the five-sixteenths, got set down swinging just off the inside into the stretch, rallied with good energy to just get up for the place honors on the wire. VINNY GOODTIMES hard held off heels early down along the inside, had to steady briefly out at the three-quarter pole, worked his way out down the backside to the three path by the half mile pole, commenced a bid three to four wide on the front from the three-eighths into contention nearing the head of the stretch, swung three wide into upper stretch, offered up a good kick through the drive but was outfinished in the last jump while safely garnering the show. ALE away a bit awkward at the start, settled three wide towards the rear under a grip, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide for home, offered up a mild kick for the last major share. VIRGINIA COLONY two to three wide in pursuit from within aim, got spirited up three furlongs out, made a mild bid chasing into upper stretch then weakened in the drive. GOLD MEGILLAH three to four wide in mid pack, came under coaxing at the three-eighths pole, spun six wide into upper stretch and offered no response. ATTENBOROUGH just off the pace just off the inside, came under urging at the five-sixteenths fading, got bumped and carried four to five wide for home and weakened in the stretch. WIND OF BOSPHORUS three to four deep towards the rear, got asked and angled six to seven wide into upper stretch and offered no rally. VELVET CAP forwardly placed three wide within aim, came

under urging at the five-sixteenths, got angled five wide for home in retreat at the quarter pole and tired. ABRA on the pace in hand inside, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch, got overhauled at the three-sixteenths and folded.
