DANCING MISSILE came away in good order, showed good speed from the outside while in hand, angled in to the rail on the turn, drew clear and was ridden out to the finish. THE GOO raced close up while between rivals, chased the pace, was no match for the winner but was clearly best of the others. JOHN N TOM put in a four wide run on the turn and faded in the stretch. IAN'S ROCKET showed speed along the inside, was steadied entering the turn, raced on the rail and had no rally. FIRSTROUND KO stumbled at the start, raced wide throughout and had no rally. PAGAN PLACE showed good speed while between rivals, was steadied entering the turn and dropped back. AIRY HILL chased the pace and tired in the stretch.
