KIRTLE (GB) was rated along inside, angled out and rallied four wide approaching the stretch and finished well outside. TARNISHED LADY raced close up early, was steadied along the inside on the first turn, raced inside and lacked a rally. MALIZIOSA dropped back early and had no response when roused. BELLS FOR MARLIN chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. SUGAR DIPPED was steadied along the inside on the first turn, was rated along inside, came wide for the drive and lacked a rally. CLEFAIRY (IRE) was rank outside under restraint, raced four wide and tired.
