Footnotes

AVENGING was well rated on a loose lead, responded well when asked to pick it up leaving the far turn, extended his advantage in upper stretch and proved much the best while drifting out in the final furlong. NAUGHTY YOU was taken in hand in the early going while contending for the lead, dropped back into the first turn, was rated on the inside, moved out on the backstretch, hesitated when PICO DINERO fell with three furlongs to run, was urged while three wide on the far turn, proved no match for the winner, battled with FOURSEVENTEEN and CLAP HANDS for the place in the final furlong and secured that position. FOURSEVENTEEN was reserved while off the rail, moved closer with a half-mile to run, jumped the fallen rival near the three-eighths pole and steadied a bit, was urged along while inside on the far turn, battled for the place in the final furlong and missed that position while able to get the show. CLAP HANDS raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, was asked to pursue the leader midway through the far turn, chased into upper stretch and weakened. KING PRADA moved out on the first turn, came three wide onto the backstretch, settled on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. RAYMOND was taken back on the inside, moved out on the backstretch, swerved out sharply to avoid the fallen PICO DINERO near the three-eighths pole, was way out near the outside hedge, worked his way back to the four path near the five-sixteenths pole and failed to threaten. MYSTIC ERA settled on the inside, swerved out to avoid the fallen PICO DINERO near the three-eighths pole, dropped back to the inside and was no factor. LA FESTA E DOMANI settled towards the rear of the field, swerved out four wide to avoid the fallen rival near the three-eighths pole, dropped back to the two path and never reached contention. PICO DINERO raced inside on the first turn, settled

nicely in fourth, lost action coming to the three-eighths pole, fell and unseated the rider, got back up after a few seconds and appeared to be relatively uninjured. HIGHLIGHT hesitated at the start, dropped back on the first turn and was pulled up but walked off. Following the race, the stewards' held an inquiry into the incident near the three-eighths pole. After the review, there was no change made to the order of finish. (Rail at 18 Feet)
