The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. 123 lbs. TURF: Non-winners of \$40,000 on the turf in 2010 allowed 3 lbs.; A sweepstake on the turf in 2009-10 or four races on the turf, 5 lbs.; three races on the turf, 7lbs. DIRT: Non-winners of a graded Sweepstake on the dirt in 2009-10 allowed 3 lbs.; A sweepstake on the dirt in 2009-10, 5 lbs.; four races on the dirt, 7 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted allowance races not considered for dirt and turf). The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Thursday, August 12, 2010 with 29 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at Five and One Half Furlongs on the main track.)

AWAKINO CAT away well, was pulled off SILVER TIMBER after brushing with that foe soon after the start, raced around the turn in the four path, took off in earnest after being called upon in upper stretch, closed readily on the front runners during the run through the furlong grounds, continued onward during the ensuing furlong, despite being carried out several paths by RAVALO, then got up shortly before reaching the finish line to prove best. RAVALO advanced to contest the lead after settling into stride after the start, disputed the pace four wide with a pair of rivals, began to edge away once let out a notch in upper stretch, emerged with a clear advantage leaving the furlong grounds, but with a host of rivals in hot pursuit, dug in with good determination, despite coming out at several points under left handed encouragement during the late eighth, yielded reluctantly in deep stretch, having to settle for place honors. YIELD BOGEY unhurried while racing along the outside, was stacked six wide at the head of the stretch, then came home with good energy down the extreme outside of the course en route for the show. HOLD THE SALT fanned five into the lane, displayed a mild rally to earn the last major share. SILVER TIMBER brushed with a pair of rivals while in a bit tight shortly after the start, raced within range between rivals on the turn, angled into a traffic jam in upper stretch, searched for optimal racing clearance until midstretch, gained sufficient room by then, was asked for a response but failed to muster up the needed kick. PERFECT OFFICER raced along the outside, entered the stretch, only to be blocked behind rivals until the sixteenth pole. OUR FRIEND HARVEY well placed in the two path off the pace tussle, failed to fire when called upon in the stretch. AHVEE'S DESTINY vied between rivals while travelling in the three path and gave way. EZZY fought for the lead with a pair from the two path, and faltered after turning for home.
