J L BERNSTEIN was placed under an early snug hold after establishing control, showed the way from the inside, well rated and facing only mildest resistance, continued along on the same scenario until the quarter pole, responded positively when given his cue, held sway, kept under active handling to the end. COLJAK patiently prompted the top one from the two path, got called upon entering the stretch, proved no match. STUD MUFFIN tracked the front runners taking the inside route, narrowed the gap down the backstretch, was asked to pick up the pace angling three wide for the stretch run, lacked the necessary response. SHERAGUSKA saved ground throughout. MERLIN BAY raced along the outside, was asked for run by the five-sixteenths pole, turned into the stretch from the four path but drifted outward nearly an additional path before being straightened away, came up empty. TAKE DOWN TWO three wide around both turns, folded. FRENCH TRANSITION three wide until the five-sixteenths pole, tired.
