**Footnotes**

CYBERTRON broke near the top and remained forwardly placed as the field proceeded down the backstretch, entered the turn three wide, closed the gap readily during the run around the bend and bid for command as the three front runners turned for home, won the tussle through the furlong grounds to reach the eighth pole holding a slim advantage, drew clear being hand urged. LEROIDESSIOUX left the backstretch as the main pursuer of the pacesetter, needed encouragement by the midway point on the turn to keep pace, narrowed in coming to the quarter pole with the eventual winner in tow one path directly to the outside, failed to keep up with CYBERTRON leaving the furlong marker, but continued onward willingly to take the place. GREY FOOSE cleared the field in the early stages and was guided over to the rail, showed the way facing little resistance until the quarter pole, had the first two finishers crank up the pressure at that juncture, held his ground well for about another furlong before backing away. REDEMPTION ROAD made solid contact with SHANE ROARS just of the starting gate, raced along the two path, was under a drive a few jumps before reaching the five-sixteenths pole, lacked the needed response. MASTER SPLASH off the inside, was no factor. SHANE ROARS bumped soundly at the start, was sent into the two path at the midway point on the turn, stayed within contention until mid lane and tired. GRAMERCY raced along the outside and failed to reach a contending position. WARRIOR FROM ABOVE took the inside route, was put to a prolonged drive, cut the corner into the lane and soon flattened out. SHOUTOUT tucked into the pocket just before reaching the end of the backstretch, began to fall back in short order, was under the whip by the three-eighths pole, continued to lose ground nonetheless and tired. HOOKDONCHURCHPUNCH saved ground for nearly a half, drifted out badly while tiring in the stretch.
