VIOLENCE hesitated at the start then was carried in, advanced between rivals near the five-eighths pole, moved to the outside shortly thereafter, chased the leader, went three wide on the turn, dropped to one off the rail approaching the quarter-pole, pursued TITLETOWN FIVE under a left-handed whip, drifted out some inside the furlong marker, drew alongside the aforementioned rival, was switched to a right-handed whip inside the sixteenth-pole, bumped with TITLETOWN FIVE near the wire and narrowly prevailed. TITLETOWN FIVE broke in at the start, went to the front without the need of much encouragement, set the pace, controlled the action while inside on the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, drifted out outside the sixteenth-pole, was straightened by the rider, switched to a right-handed whip late, came out nearing the wire then bumped with VIOLENCE and just missed. ORB reared at the start, spotted the field several lengths by the time he got going, moved out leaving the chute, settled well behind while unhurried, was asked to pick it up while inside on the turn, came off the rail in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, swung six wide while gaining into the stretch, came under a left-handed whip outside the furlong marker and closed strongly to get the show in a big effort. BAD HOMBRE hesitated at the start, moved out while urged along, brushed with HOLDEN ON near the half-mile pole, moved up between rivals, went three wide on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. HOLDEN ON broke in at the start and brushed the inside of the gate, was urged along while off the pace, shifted out from behind rivals near the three-quarter pole, brushed with BAD HOMBRE near the half-mile pole then dropped back in hand, was urged along while three to four wide on the turn and failed to rally. BRED TO BOSS broke in front then came outward, dropped back while urged along, raced four wide on the turn and came up empty. DEMOGRAPHIC TREND was urged along on the inside, saved ground on the turn and had nothing left. PAGETS was hustled from the start, chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and faded.
