NELSON AVENUE came away with no apparent mishap and easily established control, sped off from the competition under his own power, holding a healthy advantage before completing the initial quarter, sailed along in the two path down the backstretch and around the far turn, with the lead appearing at its biggest in the vicinity of the half mile pole, was still well in front when put to a drive spinning into the lane, saw the margin dwindle down making his way to the finish line but held on safely to the end. SONNYANDPALLY tucked along the rail just before reaching the end of the homestretch, tracked from afar while taking the inside route thereafter, was asked for a response at the five-sixteenths marker, didn't have enough to reel in the top one but held on well enough long enough to protect the place. POST PATTERN sat reserved from off the inside for nearly three-quarters, got angled outward into the three path leaving the midway point on the second turn, gained steadily to be along for the show. JAKE'S SHAKE three wide until the three-eighths pole, got outfinished. KNOCK QUIETLY hit the right side of the starting gate, causing the rider to lose his balance and nearly fall off, did appear to briefly lose the left iron, had the rider properly back in the saddle after going a few more strides with a fine display of athleticism, settled in midpack along the outside, chose the three path for the run around the far turn, made an abbreviated middle move to improve position, failed to sustain it upon arriving at the furlong marker. MONEYINYOUR POCKET three wide around both turns, was no threat. POTUS took the inside route, was urged cutting the corner into the lane, came up empty. SUNNY SOL RIO unhurried early, was already under encouragement coming three wide into the stretch, failed to make any impact. SAY LANCELOT between rivals and urged along on the far turn, folded.
