#### **Footnotes**

COLONEL BILL came away in good order, went three wide on the first turn, settled nicely off the pace, was roused while two then three wide on the far turn, bumped with LAKE NONA nearing the three-sixteenths pole, chased the pacesetter while under the whip, gained the lead passing the sixteenth-pole and edged clear under strong handling. HARDROCKER settled on the inside while in the front half of the field, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came out at the top of the stretch, steadied off heels nearing the three-sixteenths pole, regained momentum and moved to the outside then finished with good energy to garner the place. KATHY'S KITTEN was hustled to the lead, set the pace on the inside through solid fractions, was asked near the quarter-pole, came under the whip in upper stretch, held a clear advantage into the final furlong, was collared passing the sixteenth-pole and weakened while able to get the show. SEE ME PROUD broke out and bumped with a rival then was hustled, raced off the inside on the first turn, settled off the pace, was roused leaving the backstretch, raced off the inside while urged along on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch and improved position. SAM'S BUCK was bumped on both sides at the start then in tight, saved ground on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, came under urging with a half-mile to run, was put to the whip approaching the seven-sixteenths pole, remained well back into the stretch and also improved position. FAST GRIEVANCE settled off the pace while off the inside, was urged along while three wide early on the far turn, angled four wide near the five-sixteenths pole, caused MIGHTYLOVER to clip his heels, moved out in upper stretch and failed to rally. TYCOON CAT settled towards the rear, saved ground while urged along on the far turn and failed to threaten. CAT SWEEP saved ground on the initial turn, was unhurried towards the back, raced off the inside while urged along on the far turn, swung out at the top of the stretch, moved further to the outside while under a drive and never reached contention. EYE WITNESS tracked the pace while off the inside, was asked on the far turn, chased into upper stretch then gave way. POWERFUL INSTINCT was hustled from the start, saved ground on the first turn, settled off the inside on the backstretch, raced inside early on the far turn, angled three wide in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide into the stretch and failed to respond. LAKE NONA went two to three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, came under urging while three wide on the far turn, bumped with the hindquarters of COLONEL BILL near the three-sixteenths pole then steadied and capitulated. OUT OF YOUR MIND went three wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, was ridden along while three wide on the far turn and also failed to respond. FEAR NOTHING went three to four wide on the first turn, raced towards the front of the field, came up empty while four to five wide on the far turn, floated seven wide into the stretch and faltered. MIGHTYLOVER bumped with a rival at the start then was hustled, went three wide on the first turn, was urged along while outside on the backstretch, went four wide early on the far turn, moved to five wide nearing the five-sixteenths pole, clipped the heels of FAST GRIEVANCE when that rival came out and unseated the rider.
