STRONG IMPACT settled on the inside while under some urging, moved off the hedge near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted three wide outside the quarter-pole, chased in upper stretch, was put to the whip passing the furlong marker, continued to pursue MARQUET CAT into the final sixteenth and surged past that rival near the wire. MARQUET CAT came away in good order, was hustled to the lead, moved clear passing the half-mile pole, controlled the action through fast fractions, raced inside on the turn, was put to the whip in upper stretch, remained clear into the final sixteenth but was denied. COUNT CATAMOUNT bobbled at the start, was urged along towards the front, chased three then two wide on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and weakened while able to hold the show. IVANHO was urged along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and improved position. SOUTHPAW SLAMMER bumped hard with TAZERED at the start, showed good speed then chased the leader, raced off the hedge on the turn and tired. SEVEN LIVELY SINS was ridden along towards the inside, came off the hedge near the five-sixteenths pole and failed to rally. TAZERED was last away

then bumped hard with SOUTHPAW SLAMMER and was turned sideways, settled at the rear, went three then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. CLIP THE COUPONS settled off the pace, was urged along while off the rail on the turn and failed to respond. ELUSIVE STORY broke open the front of his stall door prior to the start, was backed out then deemed fit to run by the state veterinarian, raced on the outside while urged along, went four wide on the turn and came up empty. ALSTON GUNTER settled off the pace, threw his head while behind rivals near the seven-sixteenths pole then was taken up, went three to four wide on the turn and also failed to respond.
