BOSTON PROPER broke alertly and was placed under a firm hold by the pilot right afterwards, chased from afar down the backstretch, departed it three wide and closed in on the runaway rival, was under a drive a couple of jumps before spinning into the lane, rapidly cut into the lead during the ensuing furlong, forged on ahead with continued success, began to drift towards the outside at the sixteenth marker, ignoring some strong right handed stick work used by the rider as a countermeasure, beat GREY OAK by a head in overhauling COMANDANTE in the final stages and edged away. ESCAPE ARTIST raced three wide to four wide on the turn, made some progress on the leader after leaving the backstretch, got set down for the drive, shadowed the top one towards the middle of the strip for a good portion of the final sixteenth, forged on with good courage to procure the place. GREY OAK lost his footing at the break, had a ground-saving journey and finished willingly to secure the show. COMANDANTE shook off MEEKER AVENUE after racing latched on to that rival for a brief period and spurted away, was placed on to the inside route a short distance past the end of the chute, continued along on an ambitious mission, building up his biggest advantage between calls, heard hoof steps in the distance spinning into the stretch and got set down, arrived at the eighth pole with the margin having been dwindled down to a precious few lengths and having drifted into the two path, got run down by a threesome well past the sixteenth pole. FLYING BIRD two wide on the turn, was put to a hard drive leaving the five-sixteenths pole, made no impact. INVOCATION swung six wide into the stretch, had no offering. MEEKER AVENUE raced hitched up with COMANDANTE proceeding along the chute for a few strides, tipped into the two path once the previously-named opponent was guided over to the rail, stalked from afar and gave way.
