Footnotes

GHOSTLY VISION came away in good order, raced off the rail early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, settled in third while well behind the top two, moved closer while inside early on the far turn, shifted three wide while gaining late on that bend, swept to the front at the top of the stretch and drew away under steady urging. ALCOLITE was taken back early then reserved while off the rail, came under urging on the far turn, dropped closer to the inside outside the quarter-pole and narrowly earned the place while no match for the winner. SMOKIN CANDY went three to four wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and finished with late energy to just miss the place. STREET LORD was restless in the gate, saved ground on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, advanced inside while urged along early on the far turn, shifted four wide late on that bend, drifted in under a right-handed whip near the furlong marker and narrowly missed the trifecta. BEAT OF THE DRUM went four then three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, took the lead while three wide early on the far turn, dropped in while moving clear at the five-sixteenths, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and tired. EGO FRIENDLY was unprepared for the start, broke about three lengths slow, saved ground on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, was ridden along on the far turn, raced under the whip in upper stretch and faltered then was eased in the final furlong but walked off. READ THE PROPOSAL sped to the front, went three then two wide on the first turn, set the pace through quick fractions, lost the lead while off the rail early on the far turn and stopped then was eased but walked off. SATURDAY APPEAL lugged out a bit while three to four wide on the first turn, raced on the outside in the front half of the field, lugged out some while four wide on the far turn, floated six wide into the stretch and also faltered then was eased but walked off. ARTIE LUVSTO PARTY broke two lengths slow, lagged at the rear while off the inside and was outrun then eased in the stretch but again walked off.
