CHANNEL MARKER settled into the pocket shortly after the start, patiently tracked the disputed pace from there, found room and got angled outward turning for home, was given his cue and took off in earnest after the leader, out dueled that opponent, taking over and edging away a few strides before reaching the finish line. PARTLY MOCHA pressed the issue from the outside, had the battle spill over after entering the stretch, fought his way past SKYLANDER racing through the furlong grounds to be the new leader with an eighth to, but with the eventual winner having settled into his best stride and lurking a danger, sparred determinedly before relinquishing in the final stages. JOE CAN GALLOP three wide off the pace contestants, rallied mildly en route for the show. SHADOW ROCK between rivals nearing the end of the backstretch, fought fiercely against the strong left grip being applied by the pilot at that juncture, headed cocked menacingly in the direction of the rival to his inside, that being NEVER THE END, was under encouragement starting the drive home from the three path, lacked the needed response. RICHMOND COUNTY three wide entering the turn and five wide exiting, had no rally. SKYLANDER vied from the inside with the second place finisher to hold on to a slim advantage, relinquished before reaching the eighth pole and backed away. THOMAS HILL mostly two wide on the bend, turned for home in the four path already put to solid encouragement, tired. NEVER THE END off a beat slowly, took the inside route, fighting with force on the bit for most of the way to the quarter pole, made no impact.
