### Footnotes

ADMONISH, unhurried while outrun early, circled five entering the stretch, reached the front leaving the eighth pole and quickly drew off under a drive. LAYOUNNE showed speed while in hand, bid between rivals on the second turn then stayed on gamely through the stretch. WAVERING STYLE, rated between rivals, rallied inside on the second turn, was caught in traffic through much of the stretch then finished gamely once clear. EASY PASS showed good speed from the outside, raced three wide around both turns and faded in the stretch. MINIQUE, close up inside while in hand, was blocked in traffic in the stretch then rallied once clear. BAGASSE, hard-held inside in the early going, rallied inside on the final turn but was caught in traffic through the stretch. KING RING raced three wide on both turns and weakened. ROYAL CONNECTION was hustled to the front, set the pace and tired. CAPITOL REGION, rated between rivals, posed no real threat after a wide trip. ROWENA'S THEME raced inside and lacked a rally. SUNNYWENDY tired after racing four wide around both turns.
